1960

A new charter is granted to Wadsworth Schools Federal Credit Union by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare - Social Security Administration - Bureau of Federal Credit Unions. The field of membership includes the public school and public library employees who work in Medina County, Ohio. The newly formed credit union closes the year with total shares of \$4,360.81. The new Credit Union operates out of the Wadsworth Central School Annex at 168 Main Street.



1965

Name changed to Medina County Schools Federal Credit Union to better reflect the growing membership.



1970

Credit Union moves to 680 High Street, Wadsworth, Ohio.

1970

President Nixon signs legislation to amend the Federal Credit Union Act and creates the National Credit Union Administration and the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund - Deposits of the Credit Union become Federally Insured up to \$20,000.



1975

Name changed to Medina County Federal Credit Union - Charter expanded to include the county employees.



1978

Assets surpass the \$1,000,000 mark.

1980

Credit Union moves to 676-B High Street, Wadsworth, Ohio.

1983

Credit Union moves to 789 High Street, Wadsworth, Ohio.

1983

Charter expanded to include the employees of Lodi Community Hospital.





1985

Checking accounts are introduced. Originally called "Share Draft Accounts" the Credit Union closes the year with \$100,189 in share draft deposits.



1990

Charter expanded to include the employees of Medina General Hospital.

1990

Charter expanded to include the employees of the City of Medina.

1987

The Credit Union begins writing real estate loans and closes the year with 13 home equity loans totaling \$203,357.



1996

The Credit Union starts a first mortgage loan program and closes the year with 1 loan for \$76,950.

1996

The Credit Union opens its first branch office in the Professional Building at 120 W. Washington Street, in Medina.

2001

Ground breaking ceremony for the main office expansion.

2006

Once again, Medina Branch outgrows its space and moves to its current location in the Russell Building at 3848 Medina Road, in Medina.



2008

A ribbon cutting ceremony opens our first branch in Brunswick, located in Shenandoah Plaza at 1136 Pearl Road, Brunswick, Ohio.

1993

Assets surpass the \$10,000,000 mark.

1988

Credit Union moves to its new building at 1353 Reimer Road, Wadsworth, Ohio.

1994

Charter expanded to include groups of persons with occupational common bonds which are located within 25 miles of the Credit Union's service facilities, which have provided a written request for credit union services.



1999

Medina Branch outgrows its space and moves to Washington Park at 807 E. Washington Street, in Medina.

1999

The conversion from a common bond charter to a community charter is approved by the National Credit Union Administration - Charter changed to include persons who live, work, worship, or go to school in, and businesses and other legal entities located in Medina County, Ohio.

2009

Assets surpass the \$50,000,000 mark.

2010

The Credit Union joins Credit Union Service Centers, the national shared branching network, adding over 4,000 new service locations.



1986

The Credit Union acquires land at the corner of Clark and Reimer roads to build a new office. The land is purchased for \$37,500.
